What have we done so far?

As our project is coming to an end, let us remind you what we have prepared for you!

As part of our VR4LL, we have created four different virtual worlds that will be used as virtual environments for language learning tasks: an international space station, a deserted tropical island, a square in ancient Rome, and a world covered in ice. Each of these worlds was chosen to facilitate different types of tasks, such as escape-room style activities, giving and following directions and collaborating on creative constructions. To accompany them and make teachers' job easier once they start implementing virtual worlds in their classrooms, we have prepared Teachers' Notes, available in all partner languages.



Transnational project meeting

Off to Split, one final time!



Jantar – IH Split welcomed project partners for one final transnational meeting before the VR4LL project comes to an end. The meeting took place from 6 to 7 July 2022.

Besides final administrative points, the main focus of the meeting was the discussion of all the developed IOs and the final conference in Split. The discussion was led around the organization of local multiplier events and the upcoming final conference with a clear distribution of roles.

Partners worked hard on the creation of the intellectual outputs and expressed their satisfaction with the final versions. As of September, they will be made fully public in the Oculus store!

As dissemination and sustainability are crucial at this stage, partners agreed to make teacher's notes available on the VR4LL website and the partner websites as well as on the Erasmus Results Page.

Ideas for further development of the project were presented, with emphasis on suggestions received through feedback from participants involved in the piloting.

All partners are confident that the VR4LL project was very successful for all stakeholders: schools, teachers and students. Everyone is happy with the developed results and how their teams implemented VR in classrooms. All partners are keen on continuing to develop this technology with a follow-up project. Therefore, partners agree to submit a continuing project proposal in March of 2023.

Final Conference

ADRIES 2022, July 7-9, Split, Croatia, Radisson Blu Hotel



In 2017 a group of enthusiasts organized the first ADRIES – Adriatic Education Development Research & Innovation Symposium. It was the first international conference for language schools to be organized in the beautiful city of Split, Croatia.

ADRIES VR4LL showcased the project results, but also introduced general concepts of VR and the Metaverse to language schools.

Through this two-day event, partners demonstrated project results and their use in language teaching classrooms. They also brought a number of globally recognized speakers in the field of Virtual Reality in education. We presented innovative teaching approaches and the development and implementation of innovative technologies in language learning.



Besides that, we introduced Erasmus grant opportunities for language schools and other adult education providers. In addition, we featured practical workshops designed to facilitate the development of project ideas, and the formation of project teams. We managed to create a number of viable project proposals that can be submitted for the next call-for-proposals, in March 2023.



Last but not least, an unforgettable networking event – a sunset cruise on the beautiful Adriatic Sea – helped in the creation of a European network of language schools with the capacity to submit grant proposals and carry out Erasmus KA2 projects for years to come.
